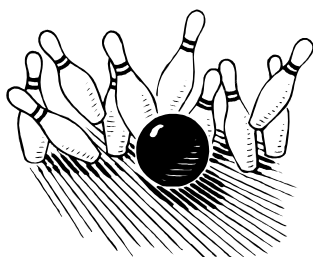


Hi All,
